In recent years our Village has achieved recognition throughout Illinois and the nation.

As "home" of the prestigious Illinois Junior Miss Pageant and recipient of Look magazine's coveted All-America City award, Niles indeed boasts a proud history of nearly 150 years.

William Ogden Niles, who owned and operated a country newspaper, The Register, is believed to be among the earliest settlers of the Village that now bears his name. During the Civil War, with a population of less than 500, Niles was comprised of a drug store and harness shop, several retail stores, two schools and a grist mill, located near Milwaukee Avenue on North Branch Road.

In 1902, residents decided to incorporate as a Village.

Although growth was slow in the years that followed (2,000 people in 1940, for instance), the Village was thoughtfully developed to achieve a balance between the residential community and the business and industrial community.

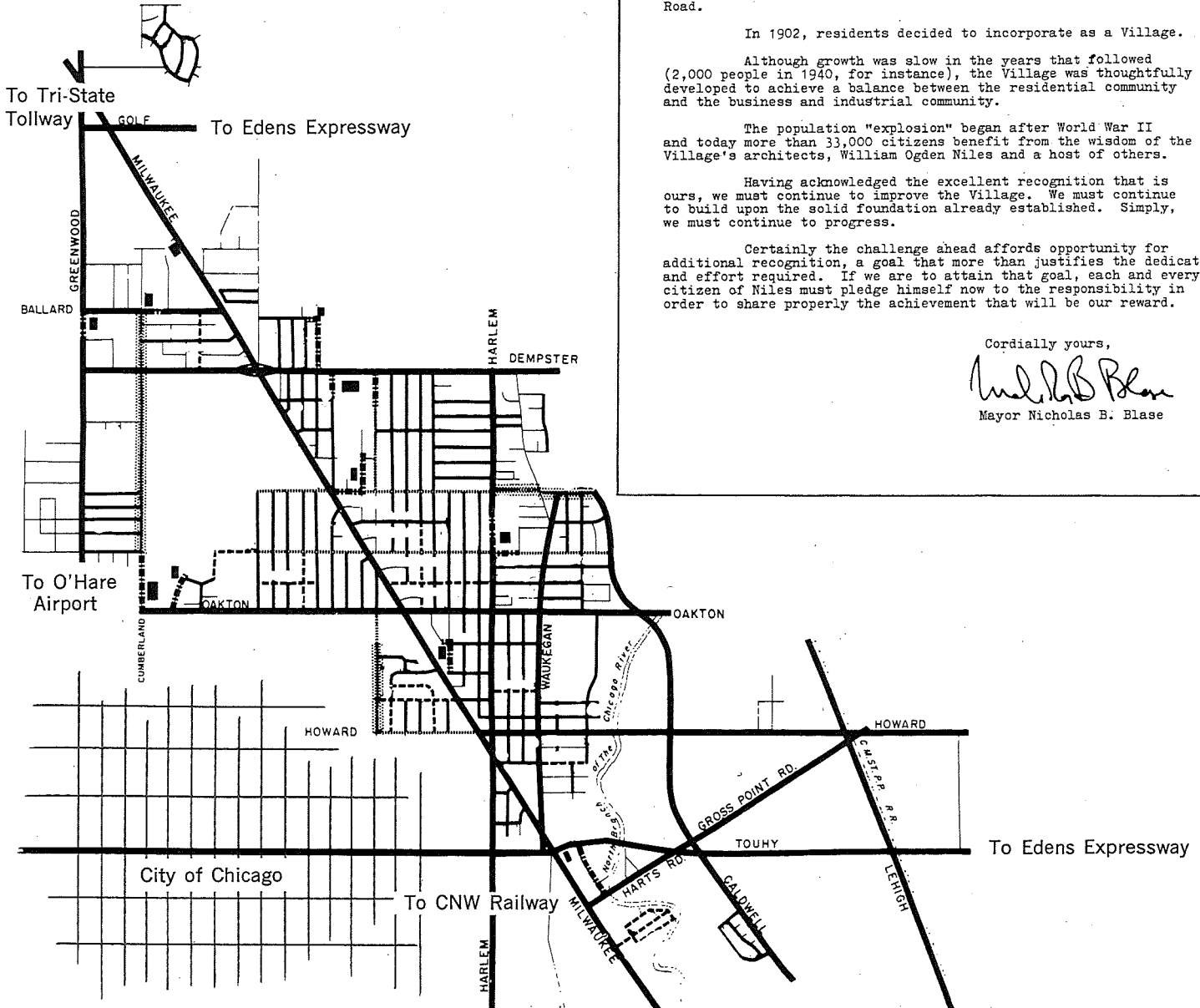
The population "explosion" began after World War II and today more than 33,000 citizens benefit from the wisdom of the Village's architects, William Ogden Niles and a host of others.

Having acknowledged the excellent recognition that is ours, we must continue to improve the Village. We must continue to build upon the solid foundation already established. Simply, we must continue to progress.

Certainly the challenge ahead affords opportunity for additional recognition, a goal that more than justifies the dedication and effort required. If we are to attain that goal, each and every citizen of Niles must pledge himself now to the responsibility in order to share properly the achievement that will be our reward.

Susan Courtney was selected Mt. Prospect's Junior Miss in November, 1966, and Illinois' Junior Miss in December at the Mill Run Theatre, Niles. In March, 1967, she traveled to Mobile, Alabama, where she was a finalist at America's Junior Miss Pageant on NBC-TV. Throughout Junior Miss competition across the

nation, 60,000 contestants annually are judged on scholastic achievement (15 per cent), an interview with judges (35 per cent), poise and appearance (15 per cent), youth fitness (15 per cent) and creative and performing arts (20 per cent). Junior Misses share nearly \$300,000 in college scholarships each year.

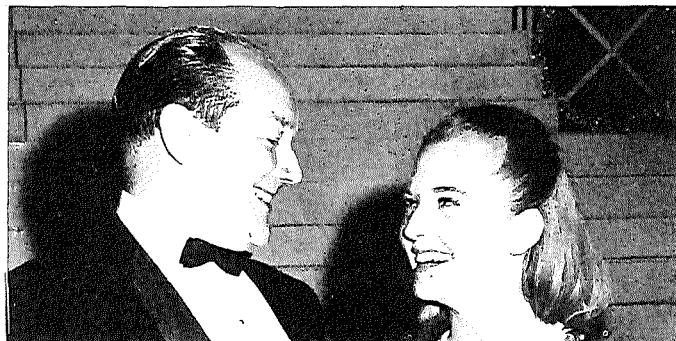
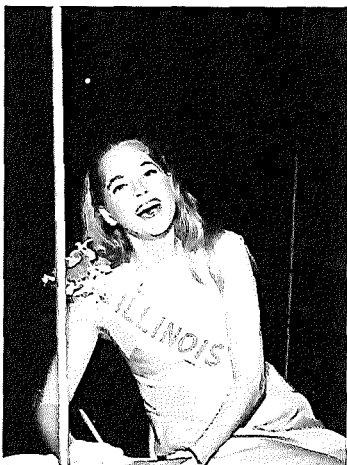

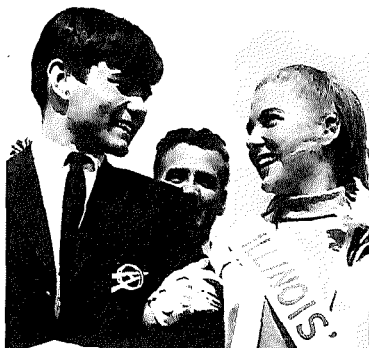

INFORMATION

VOTER INFORMATION

West of Harlem Avenue in the Village of Niles is Maine Township (10th Congressional district) and East is Niles Township (13th Congressional district). The Village is in the 4th state Congressional district and the 4th state Representative district.

GOVERNMENT

Niles operates under Village government in which voters elect a President, often referred to as Mayor, a Clerk and six Trustees.

The President, Clerk and three Trustees are elected at four year intervals, while other Trustees are elected two years later. All terms are four years.

The President, with the concurrence of the Board, makes all other appointments.

At meetings, the President presides but does not vote except in case of a tie. However, the President may veto decisions of the Board, although the veto may be overridden at a subsequent meeting.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Niles conducts regular meetings on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month at 7200 Waukegan Road, 8 p. m. Special meetings may be convened at the discretion of the Board.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Village of Niles employs a part-time sanitarian and maintains a Health Department under supervision of the Board of Health. Members are appointed by the Board of Trustees on a yearly basis.

The Department is responsible for regular inspection of all establishments that serve and/or sell

foods and beverages, and the maintenance of the highest standards of sanitation.

Further, the Department is responsible for programs of rodent control, air and water pollution, inoculation and vaccine, and medical self-help classes.

VEHICLE TAGS

All motor vehicles registered in the Village of Niles must display a vehicle tag which costs \$10 per year. Tags, which are sold December 1st and after, are displayed in the lower right corner of the windshield. Fees for trucks vary with weight.

MOTORCYCLE LICENSES

All motorcycles, motor scooters and motor bicycles registered in the Village of Niles must display a license plate which costs \$5 per year. It is illegal for more than one person to ride a motor driven cycle unless additional seats are provided and specifically designed for such additional persons. It is mandatory that all persons who ride a motor driven cycle wear a protective helmet.

DOG LICENSES

All dogs within the Village of Niles are required to wear a tag which costs \$2 per year. Dogs are not permitted at large within the Village, but must be leashed or fenced.

All of the above tags and licenses are available for sale at the Office of the Village Clerk, Municipal Building, 7166 Milwaukee Avenue, Niles.

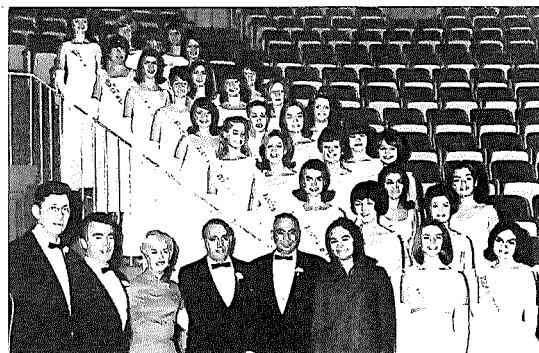
